

After serving in the Swedish Foreign Ministry (1985-1988), the World Bank in Washington DC (1988-1994), and the Permanent Representation of Sweden to the EU (1994-1998), **Anders Henriksson** joined the European Commission in 1998, holding a series of high profile posts, including Negotiator for Lithuania's accession to the European Union (2000-2003), Director for the Horn of Africa, East and Southern Africa, Indian Ocean and the Pacific (2003-2006) and Head of the Commission Representation in Sweden (2006-2009). 2009-2011 he was seconded by the Commission to the Swedish Foreign Ministry for collaborative work on the Eastern Neighbourhood of the Union, after which he pursued work on the same region outside the Commission. In September 2015 Mr. Henriksson joined the Senior Management of the Commission's Directorate-General for International Cooperation and Development (DG DEVCO) in Brussels, where he serves as Principal Adviser for Policy Definition.

Mr. Henriksson was recently appointed EU Facilitator of the Congo Basin Forest Partnership (CBFP) for the period 2016-2017.
