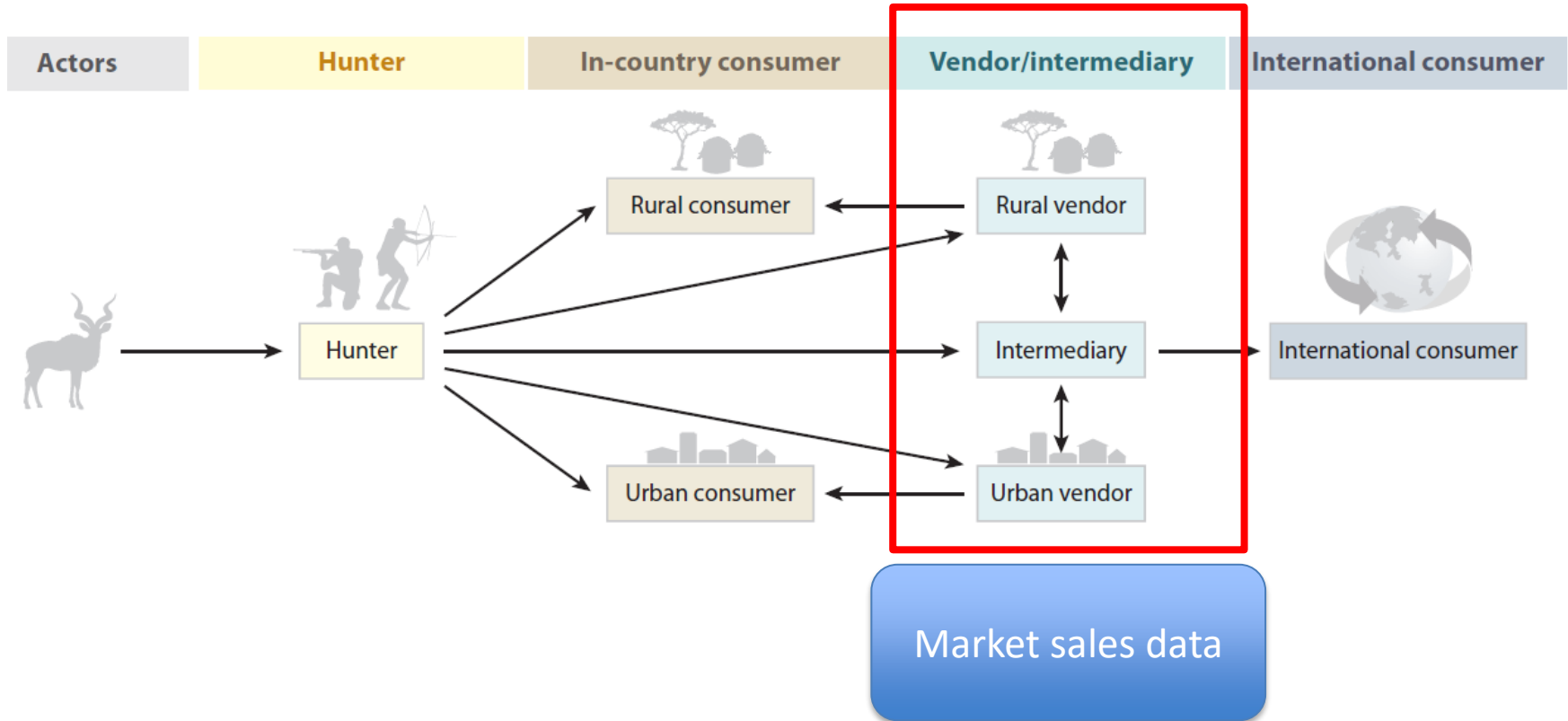

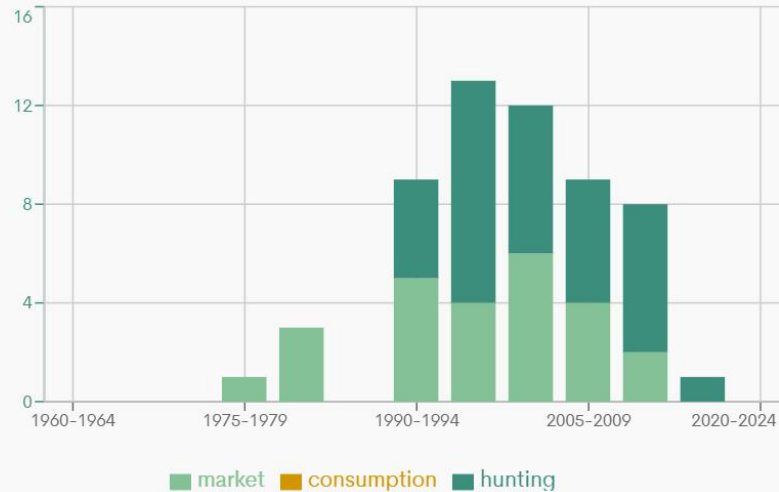

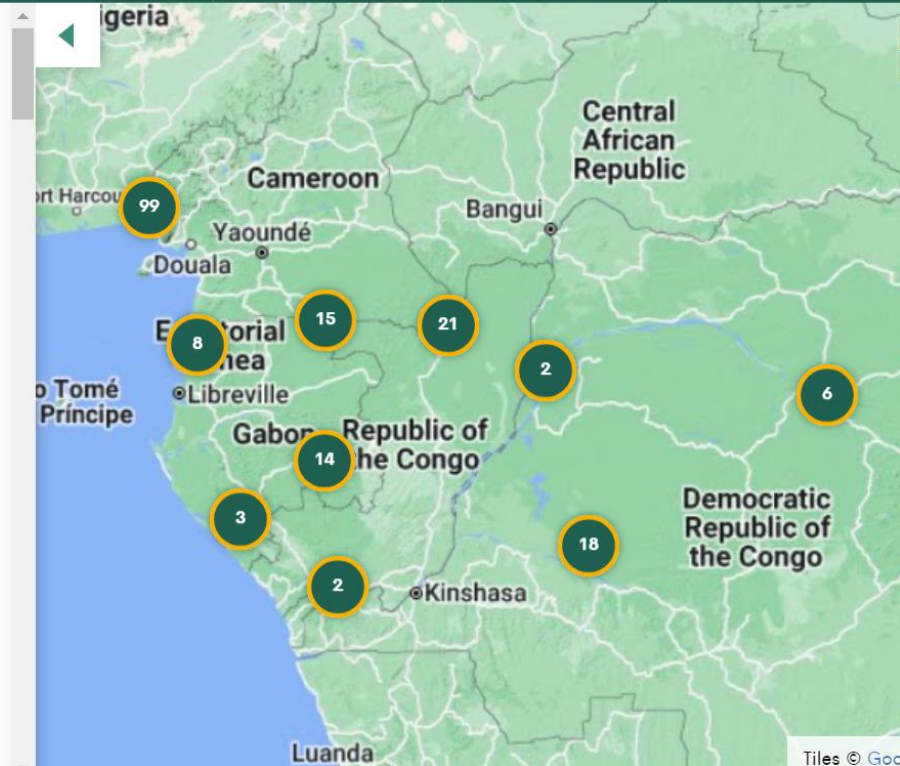
Number of studies in 5 years interval

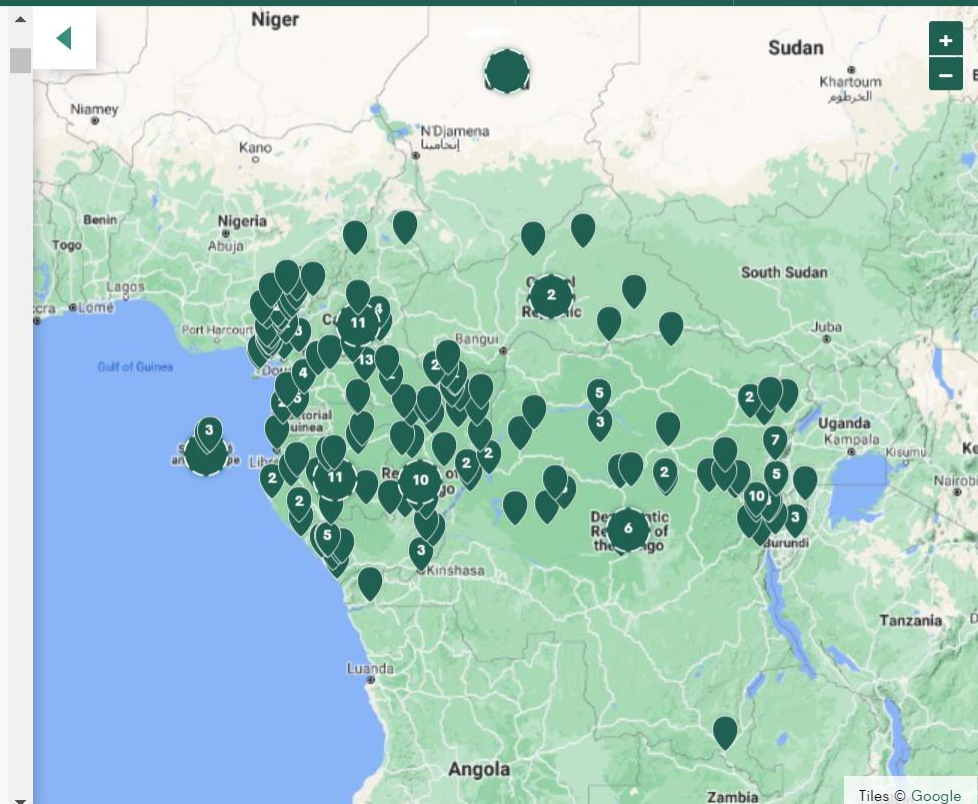

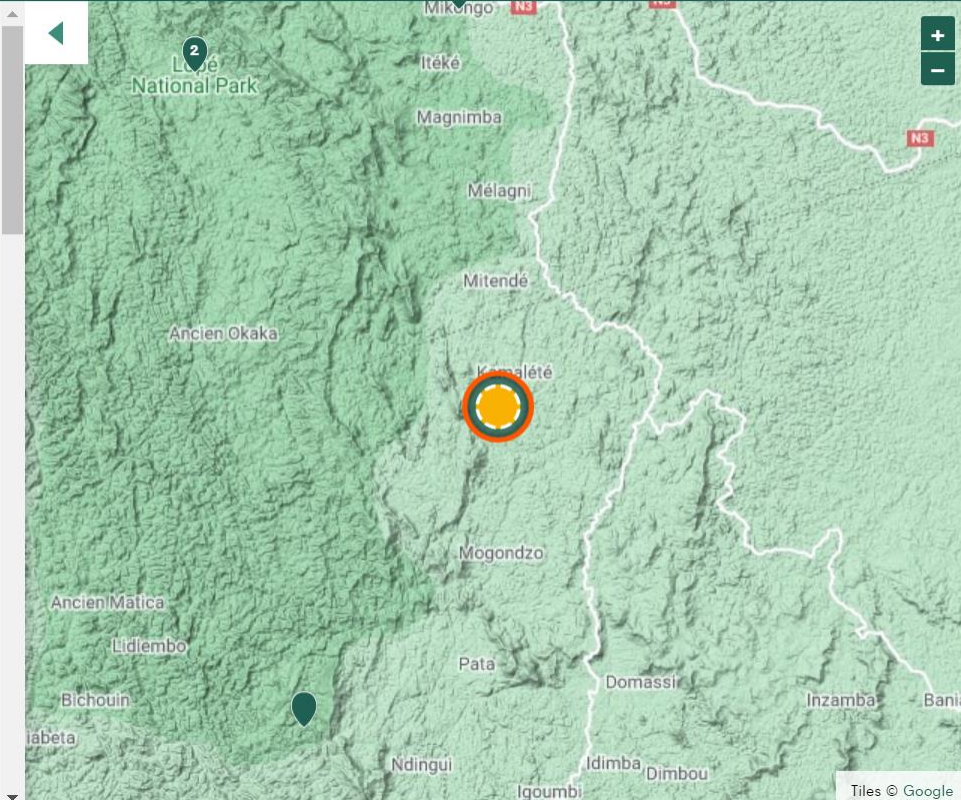

PROJECT AIMS

The Challenge Millions of people depend on wild meat and fish for food and income. Wild meat is an important source of protein, fat, and micronutrients. It is an essential part of the diet for indigenous peoples and rural communities, particularly in tropical and subtropical regions of Latin America, Africa and Asia. If hunting for wild meat is not managed at sustainable levels, then wildlife populations will decline and rural communities may suffer rising levels of food insecurity. The situation is becoming more critical as the demand for wild meat grows, particularly in urban areas where it is consumed as a luxury or tradition. In fact, recent studies estimate that 285 mammal species are already threatened with extinction due to hunting for wild meat. Sustainable Wildlife Management (SWM) Programme The SWM Programme sets out to develop sustainable solutions to tackle these challenges. It is an initiative of the African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) group of states and funded by the European Union through the 11th European Development Fund (EDF). The programme mobilizes a group of

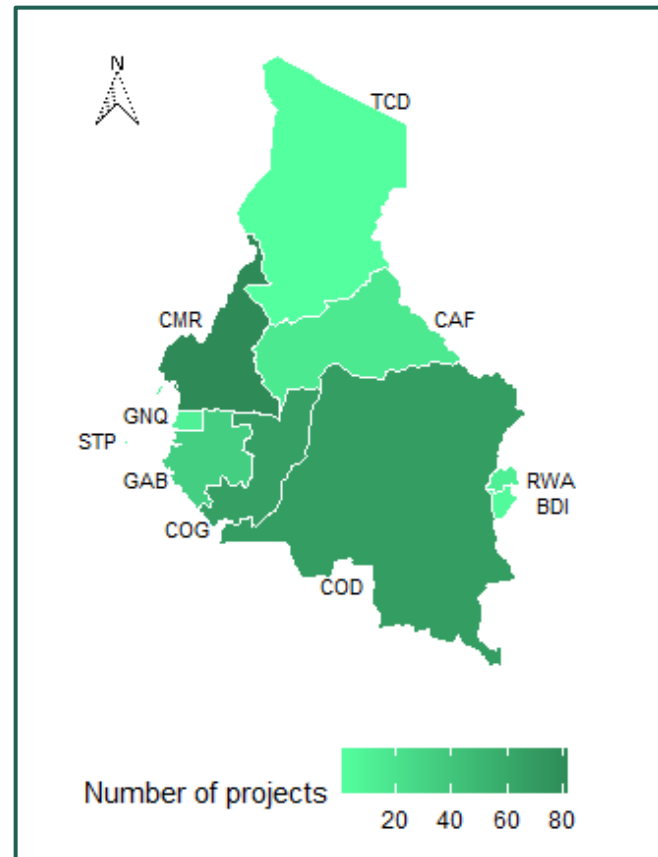
