



Facts and figures Deforestation



- Deforestation continues 7 to 13 Mio. ha/a
- Mostly in the tropics (deforestation fronts)
- second largest source of CO2-emissions
- Major driver of species loss



Facts and figures - Environmental Crime - Forest Crime

- Environmental Crime increases fast
 - → 44 % since 2014

- Envi-Crime (organized crime) third biggest crime
 - → huge profit small risk



Importance and Dimesion of the Problem

- According to Interpol 15-30 % of all wood traded globally is illegal
- 60-90 % in the tropics
- Envi-Crime is increasing law enforcement is weak (everywere)
- If we want to stop deforestation

We need to also work on envi-crime / illegal logging


