COP30: just 10 months to go...

The 30th United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP30) will take place from November 10 to 21, 2025, in Belém, in northern Brazil, the capital of the State of Pará within the Amazon. It is a key event aimed at developing strategies to stabilize greenhouse gas concentrations "at a level that prevents dangerous anthropogenic (human-induced) interference with the climate system." COP 30 is also a space for countries to obtain funding to implement their adaptation and mitigation policies for the effects of climate change.

Africa, central to the various COPs

Central Africa, despite the richness of its forest ecosystems and its position as the planet's primary lung, struggles to mobilize funding to implement activities aimed at protecting forests, combating climate change, and ensuring the region's development.

One of the reasons cited is Central Africa's participation in the various COPs in a scattered manner. While several neighbouring forest massifs plan their participation months or even years in advance, in the Congo Basin, interventions are often hastily organized at the last minute or simply cancelled for economic reasons.

All of this suppresses the voice of Central Africa and diminishes its impact during negotiations, significantly reducing the region's chances of having a well-placed pavilion to showcase the region.

Objective of the call for sponsorship

This call for sponsorship of the "COMIFAC Initiatives Pavilion" launched by the Central African Forest Commission (COMIFAC) jointly with the co-facilitation of the French and Gabonese Republics of the CBFP of the Congo Basin Forest Partnership (CBFP) aims to involve all CBFP partners to make Central Africa's participation in COP30 a success.

More specifically, it involves mobilizing funds by September 22, 2025 to:

- Acquire a strategic and highly visible space at COP30 for the "COMIFAC Initiatives Pavilion."
- Bring all the Central African countries together in the same place for greater impact
- Mobilize "Guests" or high-profile personalities for unifying debates in the pavilion.
- Strengthen the team of negotiators.









Pavilion program

- 1. High-Level Visits;
- 2. High-level VIP bilateral and multilateral meetings between Central African countries and donors (High-Level Political Dialogue Events), CBFP partners
- 3. Thematic sessions, Side Events,
- 4. Country days of the COMIFAC region (Each COMIFAC country has a time slot of 2 times 1 hour during a dedicated day,
- 5. Sessions for showcasing successful experiences, innovative results in Central Africa, and networking,
- 6. Films,
- 7. Launching events For partner announcements, the launch of initiatives, for the opening of study reports, major reports,
- 8. Congo Basin Stakeholders Voice: stakeholders' days will be organized: Youth Day, Women's Day, Local and Indigenous Peoples' Day: provide a time slot of 1h30 during a dedicated day.

Configuration of the "COMIFAC Initiatives Pavilion"

1. Office space and restricted meeting room – 40 M2

For the COP 30 in Belem, two meeting rooms (Congo Basin Room A and Congo Basin Room B) will be offered for the organization of bilateral and multilateral meetings. These two rooms of equal size, one of $10m^2$ (Congo Basin A room) and the other of $30m^2$ (Congo Basin B room), can accommodate a maximum of 10 and 30 people each. Each meeting room will be equipped with office accessories, multimedia screens, interpretation systems, etc. The Congo Basin A room would be a Lounge Salon, and the Congo Basin B room would be in a Board of Directors setting.

The reservation of each room will follow the model below. A reservation will be made online at the link below.

2 Side Event space - 70 M2

A space that can accommodate 60 people of 70 M2 for side events. Chairs arranged in a theatre setting

2. Lounge Area of the Pavilion

A dedicated space for networking, relaxation, etc.... This space will be equipped with a coffee station, information point, and lounge area.
