The World Bank Group	1000 million USD	In response to country demand and readiness, and subject to approval by its Board, the World Bank's new initiative - The Sustainable Congo Basin Forest Economies – is expected to be launched in early 2026.
Germany	450 million EUR	Largely via existing channels such as CAFI/Canopy Trust, bilateral cooperation programmes and COMIFAC. Subject to 1) the implementation of the declaration by all parties, 2) the demand and absorption capacity of the countries bilaterally, 3) the general availability of budgetary funds / parliamentary approval in the respective future federal budgets.
Green Climate Fund (GCF)	300 million USD	Contribution based on country demand through the GCF Readiness, REDD+ RBP and regular investment windows
European Commission	240 million EUR	Availability of funds in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations, policies and programmes of the Union
Norway	2500 million NOK	Subject to 1) the implementation of the declaration by all parties, 2) demonstration of needs and absorption capacity of partner countries and programmes, 3) parliamentary approval of annual budgets.

Global Environment Facility (GEF)	100 million USD	Past 4-year GEF cycle investments in the Congo have averaged \$110M. GEF-9 negotiations are underway and conditional to a successful outcome, the GEF intends to invest a minimum of \$100M during the period of 2026-2030.
Climate Investment Fund (CIF)	20 Million USD	CIF has invested close to US\$95 million in the DRC & Republic of Congo forests. This additional CIF concessional and grant funding will support MDB partners (AfDB & World Bank Group) to advance programming in 2026 that mobilizes external sources of finance, taking these investments to scale in the Congo Basin.
African Development Bank Group		Pending AfDB's President and Board approval. The amount of Bank's commitment will be communicated and included as soon as cleared by Senior Management.
Belgium		Sign up to the Declaration and a contribution will be specified at a later date.
United Kingdom		Details of the UK support will be provided in 2026
Bezos Earth Fund		Reaffirm its support for the Belem Call to Action for Congo Basin Forests and emphasise that its commitments under the Congo Basin Pledge (currently amount to USD 110 million) are still being implemented and that a possible new contribution could be announced at a later date.
