These systems are increasingly used in various fields, such as the Central African Forest Observatory (OFAC), the APES Database, the Global Forest Watch, etc. Their use in the field of protected area management or in conservation in general is a huge support to management and policy decision-making. A platform combining several key sources of information has been developed to support the management and development of conservation and research projects.
