The Congo Basin Forest Partnership (CBFP) brings together a wide variety of regional and global stakeholders around the issue of safeguarding the Congo Basin forests. They will gather on occasion of the 19th CBFP Meeting of Parties (MoP 19) from 5 to 8 July, 2022 at Radisson Blu Okoumé Palace Hotel in Libreville, Gabon.

To kick-off the diverse and ambitious technical and political discussions that will take place during the conference, we are pleased to offer you a range of exclusive MoP19 field trips, that will offer great scenery, expert inputs on a variety of themes. Field trips will take place before the beginning of the meetings, between July 02 and 04, 2022.

General Information

To get some on-the-ground impressions and inspirations ahead of the 19th CBFP Meeting of Parties, we are excited to offer you 6 field trip destinations. Each trip includes all transportation required, starting and ending at the conference hotel, provisions, entrance fees and expert/staff costs.

Multi-day trips will only run once with limited spaces available. Single-day trips may run repeatedly depending on demand. All trips are subject to a minimum and maximum number of participants admissible. If the minimum number of people is not met, the according field trips will not take place. You will receive notice of this at the latest Admission is based on a first come, first served basis. Please note that field trips are <u>optional</u>. All associated charges are at the participants cost.
